The “Inter-Art” Foundation was established in 1996 with the aim of promoting an alternative approach to contemporary art, serving as a bridge between cultures and civilizations. Through the dedication of its founding members, Stefan Balog, Ioan Hădărig and Robert Lixandru, together with those who later joined the coordination of its projects—Zoltán Balog, Elena Cristea and Andrei Bakó—the Foundation has created an international platform for contemporary artists from around the world. Its main objectives are to promote contemporary art, foster cultural exchange between artists from Romania and abroad, and organize the International Art Camp in Aiud, an annual event that brings new perspectives and artistic dialogue to the contemporary art scene.

Key Projects Organised by the “Inter-Art” Foundation

The International Art Camp in Aiud was established in 1996 at the initiative of visual artist Stefan Balog. Over the course of 28 editions, it has brought together more than 363 artists from 74 countries. Its workshops (painting, graphic arts, engraving, sculpture and installations), exhibitions and symposiums have contributed to making it one of the most important international art camps in the world.

The International Youth Creative Camp was also organised for ten years. Designed for young people aged between 12 and 16, it brought together more than 160 young artists from nine countries.

“Trance Mixion”, a computer music concert performed by Sorin Anca and Robert Lixandru (1999, 2000).

In August 2000 the **“Inter-Art” Galleries** were inaugurated. The occasion coincided with the 10th edition of the International Art Camp and the opening of the Inter-Art Contemporary Art Gallery, the nucleus of the future museum.

The “Prison Art” International Art Camp, held at the Maximum Security Prison in Aiud, was organised in 2008 and resumed in 2025. The project brought together international visual artists and incarcerated participants in a unique framework of artistic creation, dialogue and social inclusion. The first edition involved ten artists from Austria, Haiti, Morocco, Germany, Italy, Hungary and Romania, together with seven incarcerated participants, while the second edition brought together eight artists from eight European countries and nine incarcerated participants.

In October 2016, the **Small Sculpture Park** in Rome Square, Aiud, was inaugurated, featuring works created during the Inter-Art Camps in Aiud.

The “Inter-Art” Intercontinental Biennial of Small Graphics (2006–2025, 10 editions) brought together 1016 artworks from 74 countries.

The International Mail Art Exhibitions, initiated by Ioan Hădărig, have reached 32 editions to date, each dedicated to a different theme.

The “Inter-Art” Workshop of Photographic Art, an event dedicated to photographic exploration and artistic creation, brought together photographers interested in experiencing the “Inter-Art phenomenon” in Aiud (July 2017).

Intercontinental Children Art Exhibition (2020–2026, 7 editions) gathered 801 artworks from 41 countries and regions.

“Graphic Feelings”, an online exhibition, brought together 66 artists and their works from 50 countries (October 2020).

“United Nations, 80 Years for Freedom and Peace”, an intercontinental art exhibition presented at the United Nations Headquarters, New York, bringing together 216 artists from all 193 United Nations Member States across six continents. The project marked the 80th anniversary of the United Nations and represented the first art exhibition in history to include all UN Member States in a single artistic event (December 2025).

“Constantin Brâncuși – 150 Years”, an international cultural and artistic project dedicated to the 150th anniversary of the birth of Constantin Brâncuși. The project brought together simultaneous exhibitions inaugurated on 19 February 2026 in 21 countries across six continents, featuring works by 29 contemporary Romanian artists created using traditional printmaking techniques.

“Erenus Days in Alba Iulia” (2026), a Romanian–Turkish cultural programme featuring visual arts exhibitions, music performances and intercultural dialogue.

The 1st International Sculpture Triennial “Constantin Brâncuși”, organised in partnership with the National Museum “Constantin Brâncuși”, bringing together sculptors from 25 countries (2026).
